

PLANNING MONTH BIKE AND BUS TOURS



October is National Community Planning Month. Planning is the process of envisioning, mapping or otherwise conceiving of how a community will look, grow, and define itself, and much of what makes Boulder County a special place has been the result of decades of careful planning. From where you live, to how you commute, to the type of home you live in, planning helps shape the community around us. Please join us for these planning month events!

Planning Highlights Bike and Bus Tours

What: Join Boulder County, City of Louisville, City of Lafayette, and City of Superior planning staff on a guided bike or bus tour of Southeast Boulder County to showcase examples of "planning in action." Come along for the ride and learn how land use planning, transportation planning, open space preservation, housing, and historic preservation have shaped the cities and Boulder County's past, present and future. The tours are free and open to the public; anyone interested in learning more about planning in Boulder County is encouraged to register in advance (link below).

When: Saturday, October 21, 8:45 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Start & End: Picnic Shelter at Louisville Community Park, 955 Bella Vista Dr, Louisville, CO 80027.

Optional end point for the bike tours: please feel free to stop your journey at Lucky Pie/Sweet Cow at 637 Front St.

Long Bike Tour: A 20 mile figure eight loop through Louisville, Lafayette, Superior and Boulder County Open Space on mostly quiet roads and regional trails with planning highlights at 12 stops. Elevation gain is limited to approximately 770 ft and surfaces are a mix of paved roads, soft-surface trails, and concrete trails.

Short Bike Tour: A 7 mile loop through Louisville, Lafayette, and Boulder County Open Space on mostly quiet roads and regional trails with planning highlights at 6 stops. Elevation gain is limited to approximately 230 ft and surfaces are a mix of paved roads, soft-surface trails, and concrete trails.

Bus Tour: An approximately 2.5 hour tour through Louisville, Lafayette, Superior, and Boulder County Open Space with planning highlights and a few stops. The bus is wheelchair accessible.

Please bring water bottles and a few snacks.

We will have water jugs for refills and a some snacks available.
